

Using a multidisciplinary approach, the Diploma of Engineering is a practical course which will prepare you to design sustainable and creative solutions to complex and technical problems.

You'll get an introduction to civil, electrical and mechanical engineering, and begin to make ideas commercially viable as you bring them to life.

Depending on your chosen La Trobe degree, you'll develop skills in a number of core areas like biomedical engineering, communication engineering, electronic and electrical systems, sustainability in energy production, automotive engineering, the application of technology in modern medicine, project management of large-scale projects, sustainable infrastructure, water resources, civil construction, surveying and computer-aided design.





Diploma of Psychology



If you're interested in psychology or aim to become a professional psychologist, the Diploma of Psychology offers a hands-on pathway into university studies.

You'll get an introduction to subjects relating to statistics, psychology and human behaviour, with a focus on clinical neuroscience. You'll also learn about the psychology of culture and global citizenship, human relationships or even animal-human relationships.

After meeting minimum subject requirements, you'll be able to start in the second year of a Bachelor of Psychological Science at La Trobe University. Graduates of this degree often pursue careers as counsellors, public health workers, child protection officers, rehabilitation workers, youth workers or even human resources officers.

If you're planning to work as a registered psychologist you'll need to undertake further studies after your Bachelor's, including a fourth year of study and a postgraduate degree or work placement.






Sharpen your competitive edge

Scholarships



Future and current La Trobe College Australia students can receive scholarships which recognise academic performance.

La Trobe International Scholarships and Region-Specific Scholarships

La Trobe University values academic excellence. If you achieve outstanding results while at La Trobe College Australia, you may be eligible to receive a scholarship for the duration of your intended studies at La Trobe.

The scholarships offer a fee reduction of 15, 20, 25 or 30 per cent on annual tuition fees for the duration of your studies and are limited in number.

La Trobe College Australia Region-Specific Scholarships

La Trobe College Australia is offering our students from Greater China, South Asia, South East Asia, Latin America, Jordan and Turkey scholarships to support your study in Australia. These scholarships will automatically be offered to eligible students –however, some are limited and will be awarded in order of acceptance.

Family bursaries

La Trobe College Australia offers financial support in the form of family bursaries. A bursary applies where two or more students from the same family study with La Trobe College Australia or another Navitas member institution.

The bursary is equivalent to 10 per cent of the tuition fee for up to 8 units of study within one program only with a Navitas member institution.

Academic Merit Scholarships

La Trobe College Australia is committed to helping you achieve your career goals by offering scholarships to outstanding students.

Each term, we award two students with academic merit scholarships. The scholarship is for diploma students only, who are studying full-time and are in their first trimester.
